Large installation pieces include BrightWater Culinary School's Tendril, a sixty-five foot 3-panel curtain and blackout curtains for the Yayoi Kusama, Infinity-Mirrored Room installation My Heart Is Dancing into the Universe, commissioned by Crystal Bridges Museum of American Art.

I began this fiberarts piece while being an artist-in-residence (Lucky Star Farm in historical Rush district), from dyeing fabrics using indigo and organic cotton planted on the farm. I also used upcycled clothing, various threads, paints, and eco dyeing with plants.
