Bio

Chuck Davis (b. 1954) earned a BAFA – (History of Photography) from the University of New Mexico, and an MFA in Visual Arts from Lesley Art + Design in Cambridge Massachusetts. He studied Photojournalism at the University of Missouri, earning an B.A. Honors degree. Completing a residency at Casa Ranzini in Sao Paulo Brazil in 2019, he was awarded an Arkansas Arts Humanity Grant in 2022, an Art + Everywhere Grant in 2024, and he earned an Arkansas Artist Fellowship award in 2025. During 2021, he received a stipend award, a solo exhibition, and his work was entered to the collection of the Regional Art Museum (RAM) in Fort Smith, Arkansas. Earlier this year, he exhibited at MASS MOCA while on retreat, and completed a residency at Gallery RAG in Gloucester MA. During November and December, Chuck has a solo exhibit at Mount Sequoyah, Fayetteville AR.
