## Bio

Born in Rome to an Italian father and an American mother who also happened to be an art historian, Christina Mariotti grew up exposed to art from an early age. Traveling back and forth between her two hometowns of Rome, Italy and Kansas City, Missouri, she acquired artistic influences from both cultures – from classical and modern architecture to vintage fashions, interiors and more. These influences can be clearly seen in her art today, whether in her landscapes or figural works. Mariotti moved to Fayetteville in the '90s to attend the University of Arkansas, where she received her fine arts degree in painting. In addition to her studio art practice, she is also an early childhood arts educator.
