Artist Statement

Drawing inspiration from everyday life, I capture expressions, emotions, and feelings in my work. My goal is for viewers to continually imagine and savor the moment when encountering my art.

In my prints, tears are often present, sometimes visibly, sometimes subtly. These tears represent pain, hope, and at times, joy. When people encounter my prints, I want them to reflect on the emotions they have felt and find hope.

I am currently working on an emotion series that explores and expresses various emotions we experience daily, aiming to connect deeply with viewers through shared feelings and moments. So far, seven episodes have been completed, and work is ongoing.
