## How does Take A Seat work?

Once you send in the application, a representative from Walton Arts Center will review it and be in touch. If approved, you will then receive a list of shows to choose from. Participating organizations are asked to request tickets from the list based on the interest and preference of the individuals they serve. For each show in which there is interest, please indicate how many tickets you'd like. Feel free to look at the show section on the Walton Arts Center website for more detailed information about the performances offered. Please make sure to note if you have any kind of special seating request, and we will try to accommodate you the best we can.

**Please note** that while all performances that are marked with "10x10" are great for families with older children (5+), most require long stretches of sitting quietly and are not designed for young children. Jazz and dance performances are intended for older audiences as well and thus would not be appropriate for children under the age of 10. Also, we invite you to join us for the free pre-show Creative Conversation with the artists one hour before any of the 10x10 performances. Please encourage your clients to take part in this special experience!

Patrons will be given priority seating based on the order in which we receive the requests and the availability of seats for the performance.

**On the day of the show**, all tickets will be left at Will Call for your group leader to pick up and distribute to the group before the performance; any tickets left at Will Call 15 minutes prior to the show's start will be subject to redistribution to the general public, if the show is near or at capacity. If for any reason your group will not be able to attend or your number of tickets needs changing, please contact us so we can update your order.
